Your Excellency:

We are writing as members of Amnesty International Group 64, located in California. We have followed Argentine politics for several years because our group has adopted as its "prisoners of conscience" Federico Alvarez Rojas Jr. and Graciela Leikis de Alvarez Rojas, who were kidnapped from their home in Buenos Aires on October 1, 1976. Mr. Alvarez Rojas was a physicist at the Argentine National Atomic Energy Commission and his wife was a computer programmer.

All inquiries about the Rojas couple to date have gone unanswered. We would like to take this opportunity to ask whether you have obtained any information about them in the course of your investigation into the disappearances of people in Argentina. If so, please advise us what you have learned.

We would like to affirm our support and commend you on your efforts on behalf of the disappeared. We urge you to continue your work on behalf of the Rojas and all other disappeared persons in Argentina.
